Paul was originally named Saul and is first mentioned - Acts 7:58

Saul held the coats at the death of Stephen - Acts 7:58

Saul was in full agreement about the death of Stephen - Acts 8:1

Saul chose to take the lead in trying to destroy the church - Acts 8:3

Saul received permission to arrest any Christians in Damascus - Acts 9:1-2

Saul was stopped by Christ on the road to Damascus - Acts 9:3-6

Saul was chosen by God to take the Gospel to the Gentiles - Acts 9:10-22

Saul was introduced by Barnabas to the apostles - Acts 9:23-29

Saul returned to Damascus for the next ten years - Acts 9:30-31; Gal. 1:15-2:2

Saul was brought to Antioch by Barnabas - Acts 11:19-26

Saul and Barnabas were sent out by the church in Antioch - Acts 13:1-3

Saul had his name changed to Paul - Acts 13:9

Paul spent nearly three years in Ephesus - Acts 19:1-20:1

Paul wrote by the will of God

Paul wrote to the Christians in Ephesus

Paul wrote this book to the Ephesians while a prisoner in Rome - Acts 28:30-31

Paul wrote to all the faithful in Christ

We have become faithful brothers and sisters in Christ - Col. 4:9

2. Paul explained what he wanted for the Christians in Ephesus - 1:2

Paul sent a message of grace and peace

The meaning of grace

The merciful kindness of God by which He turns us to Christ - Eph. 2:8-9

Keeps, strengthens and increases us in the Christian faith - 2 Pet. 3:18

Gives us His power to grow in godly character - Titus 2:11-12

The meaning of peace

The inner tranquility of a right relationship with God - Phil. 4:7

Grace and peace come both from the Father and from Christ - 1 Cor. 1:4

B. God is the One who chose and sealed us - 1:3-14

1. This choice was made before creation - 1:3-4

a. God is blessed and blesses us - 1:3

God is the One who is blessed

God is the One who deserves all praise and honor - 1 Tim. 1:17

God is blessed because He is the Father of mercies and all comfort - 2 Cor. 1:3

God is the One who also blesses us

God also chooses to place His favor and blessing on us - Gal. 3:9

God has begotten us to a living hope through the resurrection of Christ - 1 Pet. 1:3

God blesses us with all spiritual blessings

This blessing has come on all Gentiles that are in Christ - Gal. 3:14

This means God will not withhold from us any spiritual blessing - 1 Pet. 3:9

God blesses us in the heavenlies in Christ

That Jews and Gentiles are One in Christ has been revealed - Eph. 3:8-10

This means that our blessings are spiritual and eternal - Col. 2:10

We are partakers of the heavenly calling - Heb. 3:1

b. God is the One who chose us - 1:4

God chose us to be in Christ

Being in Christ makes us a new creation - 2 Cor. 5:17

We are created in Christ unto good works - Eph. 2:10

God chose for Christ to shed His blood for us before creation - 1 Pet. 1:20

God chose us before the creation of the world

The decision to save us was made before creation - Gen. 1:1

God also chose to conform us to the image of His Son - Rom. 8:29

God chose us to be holy

This means we are set apart to God - 1 Cor. 3:9

God called us with a holy calling - 2 Tim. 1:9

God chose us to be without blame

This is the result of all our sins being placed on Christ - 2 Cor. 5:21

Through His death, Christ is able to present us blameless - Col. 1:22

Christ will present us faultless to the Father - Jude 24

God chose us to stand before Him in love

Knowing, beloved brethren your election by God - 1 Thess. 1:3-4

Because our sins were placed on Christ, we no longer stand in fear - Rev. 20:11

Instead we are able to come to God boldly - Heb. 4:16

2. This choice was to make us sons through Christ - 1:5-7

a. God chose us according to His own will - 1:5

God is the One who predestinated us to adoption

To predestine means to determine beforehand - Acts 4:28

To adopt means God determined to adopt us into His family - Eph. 1:11

God adopted us to Himself by Jesus Christ

God made us His children by His will - John 1:12

God made that possible through the death of Christ - 1 Pet. 1:18-19

God adopted us according to the good pleasure of His will

God adopted us because of His kind intent - Phil. 2:13

God adopted us because He had determined that should be done - Rom. 8:15-16

God did this to the praise of the glory of His grace

God made this choice so that He is the One who receives glory - Heb. 2:10

God made this choice so that all we do can show His grace - Eph. 2:10

b. God made us accepted through Christ - 1:6

God did this through His grace

God chose us as a free gift of His grace - Rom. 3:24

It is because of His grace we are saved - Eph. 2:8-9

God did this for us in the Beloved (Christ)

Christ offered Himself without spot to God - Heb. 9:14

God could do this because of the blood of Christ - Heb. 9:22

c. God said that it is in Christ that we have redemption - 1:7

Christ provided redemption through His blood

God sealed us with the Holy Spirit as our guarantee - Eph. 1:14

Christ is the One who paid the price to redeem us - Col. 1:14

Christ bought us back from the consequences of sin - 1 Pet. 2:24

Christ did this through the shedding of His blood - Heb. 9:26

Christ provided the forgiveness of sins

God let go of our sins because He was satisfied with the payment - 1 John 2:2

Through this Man is preached the forgiveness of sins - Acts 13:38

We have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins - Col. 1:14

Christ did this according to the riches of His grace

God's grace has no limits so He gives according to His grace - Rom. 5:17

In the ages to come He will show the exceeding riches of His grace - Eph. 2:7

a. God made His grace to overflow toward us - 1:8

This overflowing is done in all wisdom

God chose to show His grace based on His perfect wisdom - Rom. 11:33

This overflowing is done in all prudence

God chose to do this based on His perfect knowledge and holy love - Jer. 31:3

John the Baptist turned the wisdom of the disobedient to the just - Luke 1:17

b. God made known to us the mystery of His will - 1:9

God only reveals His will to those who are His friends

Christ calls His disciples, "My friends" - John 15:15

God has made His will known to us

The moment we become Christians we begin to understand:

The Word of God - 1 Cor. 2:12-13

The will of God - Col. 1:27

God has made His will known to us because that pleases Him

That pleases Him because He wants to treat us as friends - John 15:14-15

Christ shared with the Apostles many of the plans of the Father - Matt. 16:21

God has made His will known to fulfill His purpose

God is fulfilling His purpose as He makes known His will to us - Phil. 2:13

c. God is going to complete all things in Christ - 1:10

This will happen according to the time plan of God

God has the exact time for each part of His plan to be fulfilled - Matt. 25:13

This will happen because He has placed all things in Christ

The Father has placed all things under the feet of Christ - 1 Cor. 15:27

Believers will stand at the Judgment Seat of Christ - 2 Cor. 5:10

This will be where we receive our rewards - 1 Cor. 3:12-16

Unbelievers will be judged at the Great White Throne Judgment - Rev. 20:11

God will give us a summing up of all things in Christ - Rev. 20:1-6

This will happen in heaven

God will complete His plan in heaven - Heb. 9:12

One day God will wipe away every tear from our eyes - Rev. 21:4

This will happen on earth

God will complete His plan on earth - Heb. 9:14

God chose us through Christ to receive this inheritance

This inheritance makes us joint heirs with Christ - Rom. 8:14-17

This inheritance is given by God to all Christians - Acts 20:32

This inheritance includes the Holy Spirit as a down payment - Eph. 1:14

God is the One who predestinated us

To predestinate means to determine beforehand

To predestinate when God does it means to determine from eternity

God chose us to be sons from eternity - Eph. 1:5

God chose to conform us to the image of Christ - Rom. 8:29

God then called us, justified us and glorified us - Rom. 8:30

God predestinated us according to His purpose

This purpose was the cause of our salvation - 2 Tim. 1:9

This purpose was His eternal purpose - Eph. 3:11

This purpose is why God causes all things to work for good - Rom. 8:28

God works out all things according to the counsel of His will

God is the One who causes His counsel to stand - Is. 46:10

God is the One who works in us to complete His will - Phil. 2:13

God will fulfill His will by giving us eternal life - Titus 3:5-7

God has given an oath to back up this promise - Heb. 6:17

b. God is the One who deserves all praise - 1:12

God is the One who caused us to trust Christ

The Father is the One who draws us to Christ - John 6:44

The Father is the One who gives us the faith to believe - Eph. 2:8

The Father is the One who made us accepted in the Beloved - Eph. 1:6

The Father strengthens us with might through the Spirit - Eph. 3:16

The Holy Spirit is the One who brought conviction - John 16:8-11

The Son is the One who came to seek and to save - Luke 19:10

God did this to bring praise to His glory

God is the one who deserves all praise - I Cor. 10:31

The Father will even receive glory from Christ - I Cor. 15:24-28

The Father is One who bears witness of Christ - John 8:18

The word of truth is the source of the Gospel - Col. 1:4-6

The word of truth effectively worked in us - 1 Thess. 2:13

God caused us to believe in Christ

God worked through the Gospel to cause us to believe - Rom. 1:16

God worked through the Scriptures to cause us to believe - 2 Tim. 3:15

God worked through His grace to cause us to believe - Titus 2:11

God worked through other Christians to cause us to believe - Heb. 2:3

God sealed us with the Holy Spirit of promise

This seal is our down payment on eternal life - 2 Cor. 1:22

This seal has been placed in us until the day of redemption - Eph. 4:30

b. God gave us the Holy Spirit as our guarantee of eternal life - 1:14

The Holy Spirit is the guarantee of our inheritance

The Spirit reminds us we are joint heirs with Christ - Rom. 8:15-17

The Spirit reminds us of the coming redemption of our body - Rom. 8:23

The Spirit reminds us He is our down payment - 2 Cor. 5:5

The Spirit reminds us that we are children of God - Gal. 4:6

The Holy Spirit provides this guarantee unto our full redemption

Our redemption was purchased by the blood of Christ - Acts 20:28

Our redemption will be complete when we have a new body - Rom. 8:23

The Holy Spirit shows that we are now God's purchased possession

The Holy Spirit reminds us we were bought with a price - 1 Cor. 6:19-20

The Holy Spirit reminds us to glorify God both in body and in spirit - I Cor. 6:20

The Holy Spirit causes all glory to go to God

The glory belongs to God for His grace - Eph. 1:6

The glory belongs to God for our salvation - Eph. 1:12

This glory caused God to give us the Holy Spirit as a guarantee - Eph. 1:14

God shared the riches of His glory so we could be strengthened - Eph. 3:16

God deserves all glory because His power works in us - Eph. 3:20-21

God willed to make known His riches to the Gentiles also - Col. 1:27

1. Paul gave thanks for the faith and love of the Ephesians - 1:15-16

a. Paul heard about the faith and love of the Ephesians - 1:15

Word had spread about their faith in Christ

Paul had faithfully preached the message of faith to the Ephesians - Acts 20:21
Paul reminded them that they had been saved by grace through faith - Eph. 2:8-9
Paul prayed that the Christ would dwell in their hearts through faith - Eph. 3:17
Paul reminded the Ephesians that we have unity because of that faith - Eph. 4:13
Paul reminded the Ephesians that the shield of faith is our protection - Eph. 6:16

Word had spread about their love for all the saints

Christ commanded that we are to love one another as He loved us - John 13:34
Christ said that is how the world knows we are His disciples - John 13:35
God is rich in His mercy because of His great love to us - Eph. 2:4
Paul prayed they would know the love of Christ - Eph. 3:19
Paul prayed they would all grow to speak the truth in love - Eph. 4:15

b. Paul thanked God for their faith and love - 1:16

Paul prayed for them continually

Paul prayed for Christians continually - Rom. 1:9
Paul gave thanks to God every time for various churches - Phil. 1:3-4
Paul gave thanks to the Father as he prayed for Christians - Col. 1:3
Paul gave thanks for the faith, love and hope of Christians - 1 Thess. 3-4

Paul gave thanks for them continually

Paul did not cease to give thanks for Christians continually - Col. 1:9
Paul gave thanks for the grace of God as he prayed - 1 Cor. 1:4
Paul gave thanks for the love of Christ for one another - 2 Thess. 1:3

Paul prayed for them personally

Paul prayed that God would give them the spirit of wisdom - Eph. 1:17
Paul prayed the eyes of their understanding would be enlightened - Eph. 1:18
Paul prayed they would know the hope of His calling - Eph. 1:18
Paul prayed they would be strengthened with might through His Spirit - Eph. 3:16
Paul prayed Christ would dwell in their hearts by faith - Eph. 3:17
Paul prayed that they would be rooted and grounded in love - Eph. 3:17
Paul prayed they would know Christ's love in four dimensions - Eph. 3:18-19
Paul prayed they would be filled with all the fullness of God - Eph. 3:19

2. Paul prayed for growth in wisdom and knowledge - 1:17-18

a. God is the source of wisdom and knowledge - 1:17

God is the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ

Christ called Him the Father in His prayer in John 17:1-26

God is the Father of glory

The Father is the One who deserves all glory - 1 Chron. 29:11

The Father of glory is the One to whom we pray - Matt. 6:9-13

The Father is the God of glory who appeared to Abraham - Acts 7:2

God gives us the spirit of wisdom in the knowledge of Him

The Spirit of wisdom is the Holy Spirit - Is. 11:2

The Spirit of wisdom is the Spirit of truth - John 14:17

The Spirit of wisdom is the One who teaches us - John 14:26

The Spirit of wisdom gives us wisdom that is from above - James 3:17-18

God gives us the spirit of revelation in the knowledge of Him

The Spirit is the One who reveals things to us - 1 Cor. 2:1

The natural man cannot receive the things of the Spirit - 1 Cor. 2:14

The Spirit reveals the love of Christ to us - Eph. 3:18-19

b. God is the source of understanding - 1:18

God causes the eyes of our understanding to be enlightened

God is the One who opens our eyes - Psalm 119:18

God is the One who opens our understanding - Luke 24:45

God gives us light to give us understanding - 2 Cor. 4:4-6

God wants us to know the hope of His calling

In the past we were without hope - Eph. 2:12

In the present God wants us to know the hope of our calling - Eph. 4:4

We look for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of Christ - Titus 2:13

We have become heirs because of the hope of eternal life - Titus 3:7

God wants us to learn to give a defense of this hope within us - 1 Pet. 3:15

God wants us to know the riches of His glory

The riches of His glory made possible the forgiveness of sins - Eph. 1:7

The riches of His glory provide strengthening of our inner man - Eph. 3:16

The riches of His glory make it possible to know the love of Christ - Eph. 3:17-19

God wants us to understand His inheritance to the saints

That inheritance is all we will share with Christ - Rom. 8:14-17

That inheritance includes eternal life - Acts 26:18

This inheritance includes the Holy Spirit as a down payment - Eph. 1:14

3. Paul prayed for growth in understanding the power of God - 1:19-21

a. God wants us to know His power - 1:19

The power of God is shown toward Christians

This power is shown by creating us unto good works - Eph. 2:10

This power is shown by giving us power to minister - Eph. 3:7

This power means God will do through us more than we can imagine - Eph. 3:20

The power of God is working with mighty power

The power of God is able to turn us from the power of Satan - Acts 26:18

The power of God is able to save - Rom. 1:16

The power of God is able to make us new creations - 2 Cor. 5:17

The power of God works in us to complete His will - Phil. 2:13

The power of God gives us His power to witness - Acts 1:8

The power of God empowers our preaching - 1 Thess. 1:5

b. God wants us to understand why the resurrection shows His power - 1:20

God showed His power in Christ

The Father gave Christ power to rise again - John 10:18

God will also raise us up by His power - 1 Cor. 6:14

God showed His power by raising Christ from the dead

This resurrection power is only understood as we grow - Phil. 3:10

God gives great power to witness to that resurrection - Acts 4:33

God showed His power by setting Christ at His right hand

Christ is at His right hand interceding for us - Rom. 8:34

Christ always lives to make intercession for us - Heb. 7:25

c. God wants us to understand how Christ demonstrates His power - 1:21

Christ is far above all principality, power, might and dominion

God has exalted Him above all things - Phil. 2:9-11

God made Christ head of all principality and power - Col. 2:10

God created all things through Christ - Col. 1:15-19

Christ is far above every name in this present age

Christ has been given all authority - Matt. 28:18

Christ is over the principalities of this world - Eph. 6:12-13

Christ is far above every name in the age to come

Christ will raise all from the dead - John 5:25-29

Christ will be victorious over all enemies - 1 Cor. 15:23-28

4. Paul prayed for understanding of Christ, the head of the church - 1:22-23

a. God made Christ the head of the church - 1:22

Christ had all things placed under His feet

God will place all enemies under His feet - 1 Cor. 15:25-27
God placed all created things under the feet of Christ - Ps. 8:6
God will place all things under His feet - Heb. 2:8
The last enemy to be destroyed is death - 1 Cor. 15:26

Christ was made the head over all things to the church

Christ is the head of the church - Eph. 4:15-16
Christ is the Head of the body, the church - Col. 1:18
Christ has all fullness dwelling in Him - Col. 1:19
Christ is the Head who makes us complete - Col. 2:10
Christ is the Head who joins all parts together - Col. 2:19
Christ is the Head who deserves all glory - Eph. 3:21
Christ is the Head of the church - Eph. 5:23
Christ has become the chief cornerstone - 1 Pet. 2:9

b. God said that the church is the body of Christ - 1:23

The church is the body of Christ

The body of Christ makes us members of one another - Rom. 12:5
The body of Christ has many different members - 1 Cor. 12:12
The body of Christ has many individual members - 1 Cor. 12:27
The body of Christ makes both Jews and Gentiles fellow heirs - Eph. 3:6
The body of Christ is to grow to maturity - Eph. 4:12
Christ is the Savior of the body - Eph. 5:23

Christ led Paul to suffer afflictions for the sake of His body - Col. 1:24

The church is the fullness of Christ who fills all things

Of His fullness we have all received - John 1:16
Christ is the Head who is to have the pre-eminence - Col. 1:18
Christ is the One in whom all fullness dwells - Col. 1:19
Christ demonstrates all the fullness of God in bodily form - Col. 2:9
Christ is the One who makes us complete in Him - Col. 2:10
Christ is the One who triumphs over all things - Col. 3:15
Christ wants to fill us with all the fullness of God - Eph. 3:19
Christ is the One who Himself fills all things - Eph. 4:10
Christ is One who is all and in all - Col. 3:11

D. God is the One who saves us by grace - 2:1-10

1. Our past condition was spiritual deadness -2:1-3

a. We were dead in trespasses and sins - 2:1

We have been made alive

Christ came to give His life so we could have spiritual life - John 10:10

Christ is the resurrection and the life - John 11:25-26

We were dead in our sins

Spiritual death is separation from God - Gen. 3:7-10

Our former condition was we were dead in our sins - Eph. 2:5

We had spiritual blindness (darkness) in our hearts - Eph. 4:18

b. We walked according to the pattern of Satan - 2:2

We followed the pattern of the world

We followed our old man which was corrupt - Eph. 4:22

The wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience - Col. 3:6

We followed the pattern of Satan

We followed the lusts of the devil - John 8:44

We followed the spirit who deceives the world

We previously followed the spirit of the world - 1 Cor. 2:12

We followed the deceptions of evil spirits - I John 4:1-4

c. We walked according to the lusts of the flesh - 2:3

Our actions were controlled by the desires of our flesh

We followed the flesh instead of the Spirit - Gal. 5:17-21

We spent our past following the sins of the world - 1 Pet. 4:3

Our desire was to carry out the desires of our flesh

Those who are in the flesh cannot please God - Rom. 8:8

We followed the desires of our flesh - Titus 3:3

We are to make no provision for the flesh - Rom. 13:14

Our desire was to carry out the desires of our mind

We followed the thoughts of our minds - James 3:14-16

We are to be renewed in the spirit of our mind - Eph. 4:23

Our destination was wrath along with many others

We followed the pattern of the entire world - Romans 3:19-20

We had a sin nature when we were born - Ps. 51:5

2. Our present position is seated with Christ - 2:4-6

a. We are loved with a great love - 2:4

God is rich in mercy

God revealed the riches of His glory to both Jews and Gentiles - Rom. 9:23-24

The riches of His mercy are for both Jews and Gentiles - Rom. 10:12

The riches of His mercy provided forgiveness of sin - Eph. 1:7

The riches of His mercy cause Him to give us a ministry - Eph. 3:8

God has loved us with His great love

This love was so great that God gave His Son for us - John 3:14-17

God placed great love on us by calling us His children - 1 John 3:1-2

This love will give us boldness in the day of judgment - I John 4:10-19

b. We are made alive in Christ - 2:5

God reached out to us when we were dead in sins

God reached out to us when we were without strength - Rom.5:6

God showed His love to us while we were still sinners - Rom. 5:8

God awoke us from the dead - Eph. 5:14

God drew us to Christ - John 6:44

God made us alive together with Christ

God says that we have risen with Christ - Col. 3:1

God has renewed us by the Holy Spirit - Titus 3:5

Alive to Christ means sin no longer rules over us - Rom. 6:11-13

Alive in Christ means we are set free from the fear of death - Heb. 2:15

c. We have been made to sit in heavenly places with Christ - 2:6

God has raised us up together with Christ

God has already blessed us with every spiritual blessing - Eph. 1:3

God has already reserved an eternal inheritance for us - 1 Pet. 1:4

God says our lives are hidden with Christ in God - Col. 3:3

God wants us to enjoy His fellowship right now - 1 John 1:3

Christ was raised and sits at the right hand of the Father - Eph. 1:19-20

God has made us sit in heavenly places with Christ

Christ has blessed us with all spiritual blessings - Eph. 1:3

God says we are seated with Christ in heavenly places - Eph. 1:20

God has done this so the church can know His great wisdom - Eph. 3:10

3. Our future promise is to know the riches of Christ - 2:7

We can look forward to the ages to come

God says there is no fear in love - 1 John 4:18

God blesses us both in the present and in the age to come - Luke 18:30

We will see the exceeding riches of His grace

We have been justified freely by His grace - Rom. 3:24

God is rich both in mercy and love - Eph. 2:4

We will see His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus

God showed love and kindness to us in Christ - Titus 3:4

God saved us by His grace

It is through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ that we are saved - Acts 15:11

We were spiritually dead before God saved us - Eph. 2:5

We had no hope before God saved us - Eph. 2:12

We were facing eternal punishment before God saved us - 2 Thess. 1:9

God saved us through faith

By the works of the law no flesh will be justified - Gal. 2:16

We received the promise of Christ by faith - Gal. 3:22

We received the promise of the Spirit by faith - Gal. 3:14

That faith comes from hearing the Word of God - Rom. 10:17

God gave us that faith as a gift

We received Christ and eternal life as a free gift - Rom. 6:23

We received that gift by believing in our hearts - Rom. 10:9-10

b. We have not been saved by our own works - 2:9

God says our works will not save

All our righteousnesses are like filthy rags - Is. 64:6

We cannot be saved by the works of the law - Rom. 3:20

We are saved apart from the works of the law - Rom. 3:27-28

God says no one is able to boast

Boasting is excluded by the law of faith - Rom. 3:27

We can only glory in what the Lord has done - 1 Cor. 1:29-31

We were destroying ourselves as we followed our own way - Titus 3:3-5

c. We have been created for good works - 2:10

God is the workman who created us

We were made by God - Ps. 100:3

We are the work of God's own hands - Ps. 138:8

We are God's building - 1 Cor. 3:9

God created us in Christ Jesus

We were made a new creation in Christ - 2 Cor. 5:17

We are being brought to maturity in Christ - Heb. 13:20-21

God created us for good works

We have been prepared for every good work - 2 Tim. 2:21

We are to be thoroughly furnished unto all good works - 2 Tim. 3:14-17

We are to practice good works and be fruitful - Titus 3:14

E. God is the One who brings Jews and Gentiles together - 2:11-18

1. As Gentiles we had no hope - 2:11-13

a. In the past we were Gentiles in sin - 2:11

God said that we were Gentiles in the flesh

We were following the idols of the world - 1Cor. 12:2

At that time we had no hope and were without God in the world - Eph. 2:12

God said that we were Uncircumcised

We were dead in our sins and the uncircumcision of our flesh - Col. 2:13

The Jews faithfully practiced physical circumcision - Phil. 3:5

In contrast, Paul wrote about circumcision that is not of the flesh - Col. 2:11

(this is the putting off the body of the sins' of the flesh)

We are the circumcision that has no confidence in the flesh - Phil. 3:3

This comes through faith in Christ and is God's righteousness - Phil. 3:9

God said that Jews and Gentiles were separated socially by Circumcision

We could not get together with Jews - Acts 10:28, Gal. 2:11-16

In Christ we have been brought near by the blood of Christ - Eph. 2:13

True circumcision is of the heart through the work of the Holy Spirit - Rom. 2:29

Abraham received this faith while he was still uncircumcised - Rom. 4:11

Abraham thus became the father of all who walk in faith - Rom. 4:12

We now walk by faith and not by sight - 2 Cor. 5:7

b. In the past we were Gentiles separated by sin and without hope - 2:12

We were without Christ

We were the other sheep - John 10:16

Christ said we would hear His voice and become one flock - John 10:16

We had nothing in common with Israel

We were alienated from God - Eph. 4:18-19

Christ is our peace and broke down the middle wall of separation - Eph. 2:14

We did not have the covenants of promise

We did not have the promises made to Abraham - Gal. 3:16-17

The promise by faith in Christ is given to those who believe - Gal. 3:22

We did not have hope

We did not have the hope of glory revealed to us - Col. 1:26

It is Christ in us that gives us the hope of glory - Col. 1:27

We were without God in the world

We chose to substitute other things for God - 1 Cor. 8:4-6

We were alienated from the life of God - Eph. 4:18

We have been reconciled to God through the death of His Son - Rom. 5:10

We were alienated and enemies in our mind by wicked works - Col. 1:21

God has reconciled us in the body of His flesh through death - Col. 1:22

(Christ wants to present us holy, blameless and above reproach in His sight)

c. In the past we were far away from God - 2:13

God said that we were far away from Him

We had our eyes blinded to God - Acts 26:18

We judged others while sinning secretly - Rom. 2:1

We walked according to the course of this world - Eph. 2:2

We fulfilled the desires of the flesh and mind - Eph. 2:3

We were controlled by the passion of lust - 1 Thess. 4:5

God has made us near Him by the blood of Christ

The goodness of God is why God was patient with us - Rom. 2:4

God was satisfied with the blood of Christ as payment for our sins - Rom. 3:25

God gives us His strength to possess our bodies in honor - 1 Thess. 4:4

We have now been reconciled to God by Christ - 2 Cor. 5:18-21

We have been reconciled by the blood of Christ - Col. 1:13-14

Christ made peace through the blood of His cross - Col. 1:20

Without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness - Heb. 9:22

It is through the blood of Christ that we have forgiveness - Col. 1:14

Because Christ is in us, we can now fully forgive others - Col. 3:13

b. Christ is the One who ended the enmity between Jews and Gentiles - 2:15

He ended the enmity by His death

He ended the division brought by the law

The Gentiles who were far off heard the Gospel

Christ gives peace to all those who place their faith in Him - John 14:27

Gentiles were brought near by the blood of Christ - Eph. 2:13

Christ preached peace because He is our peace - Eph. 2:14

Christ accepts people of every nation - Acts 10:34-35

The Jews who were near heard the Gospel

Christ says the Gospel is for both Jews and Gentiles - Rom. 1:16

e. Christ gave us both access to the Father by the Spirit - 2:18

Through Christ both Jew and Gentiles have access to the Father

Christ is the door through which we receive this access - John 10:9

As Gentiles we are the other sheep promised access - John 10:16

We have access by faith into this grace in which we stand - Rom. 5:2

Once far off but now brought near by the blood of Christ - Eph. 2:13

We have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Christ - Eph. 3:12

We now have fellowship with both the Father and the Son - 1 John 1:3

This is accomplished by the ministry of the Holy Spirit

We have been joined together in one body - Eph. 4:16

We are becoming conformed to His glorious body - Phil. 3:20-21

We have become a part of the household of God

We all become children of God - Rom. 8:14-17

The household of God is also called the household of faith - Gal. 6:10

We can come boldly to the throne of God - Heb. 4:16

2. Christ is our chief corner stone - 2:20

We are built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets

The apostles were personally chosen by Christ - Luke 6:13, Acts 1:20-23, Gal. 1:1

The apostles gave us eyewitness testimony of the resurrection - Acts 1:21-22

The apostles were given signs and wonders to verify their testimony - Heb. 2:3-4

All Scripture was given by the inspiration of God - 2 Tim. 3:16-17

The prophets gave us the written Word of God - 2 Pet. 1:19-21

The prophets spoke as they were moved by the Holy Spirit - 2 Pet. 1:21

We have Jesus Christ, Himself, as our chief cornerstone

Peter means little stone and Christ was the great massive rock - Matt. 16:18

Christ is the living stone precious in the sight of the Father - 1 Pet. 2:4

We are living stones built on Christ, the chief cornerstone - 1 Pet. 2:5-6

3. Christ is building us all into a holy temple - 2:21

We are all to be fitly framed together

God is building us into a holy temple - 1 Cor. 3:17

God says our body is the temple of the Holy Spirit - 1 Cor. 6:19

God wants us a holy temple both in body and spirit - 1 Cor. 6:20

4. Christ is making us a fit dwelling place for God - 2:22

Paul was in prison for preaching to the Gentiles - Acts 22:17-22; 2 Cor. 4:8-15

Paul was a prisoner in Rome when he wrote this book - Acts 28:16

Paul said he was a prisoner of Jesus Christ

Paul viewed himself as a prisoner of Christ - Philem. - 1:9

Paul said he was a prisoner for the sake of the Gentiles

The church recognized Paul and Barnabas had been sent to the Gentiles - Gal. 2:9

Paul was a prisoner for the sake of the Gentiles - Col. 1:24-27

Paul said they had heard of the dispensation of this grace

The word "dispensation" means a stewardship (management) - Luke 16:2-4

God chose Paul to take the Gospel to the Gentiles - Acts 9:15-16

Apollos greatly helped those who had believed through grace - Acts 18:27-28

Paul said this grace is the grace of God

The Jewish Christians also received this message by grace - Acts 15:11

Paul had written the Christians in Rome they were justified by grace - Rom. 3:24

All Christians received salvation by grace through faith - Eph. 2:8-9

God said that Jews and Gentiles are fellow heirs of this grace - Eph. 3:6

God chose Paul to reveal the mystery of the Gospel to the Gentiles - Eph. 6:19

The grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men - Titus 2:11

Paul said he was given this message of this grace

Paul was a faithful witness of the grace of God - Acts 20:23-24

Paul had received this message from God by grace - Eph. 3:7

b. Paul had received revelation about the mystery - 3:3

God had revealed this message to Paul by revelation

God had shown Paul that He had other things to reveal to Him - Acts 26:16

God had revealed this message of grace by revelation - Col. 1:26-27

God had revealed to Paul that this was a mystery before

Paul revealed this wisdom God had hidden until Christ came - 1 Cor. 2:7

Paul and those with him were stewards of the mysteries of God - 1 Cor. 4:1

God had even caused Paul to write about this briefly

Paul had earlier mentioned the mystery of His will - Eph. 1:9-10

Paul wanted to reveal the mystery of Christ wherever he went - Col. 4:3

c. Paul said this was the mystery of Christ - 3:4

Paul said they would read about this mystery

Paul and Barnabas turned to the Gentiles to be a light to them - Acts 13:46-48

This mystery was the Gentiles would be fellow heirs with the Jews - Eph. 3:6

Paul said that then they would understand the knowledge he received

Paul was passing on this knowledge in the book of Ephesians - Eph. 1:3-4

God by His mercy made us alive together with Christ - Eph. 2:4-7

In Christ Gentiles have been brought near by the blood of Christ - Eph. 2:13

Christ is our peace who has made both one - Eph. 2:14

(Christ also broke down the middle wall of separation)

Paul said this is the mystery of Christ

Jews and Gentiles are saved by the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ - Acts 15:11

In Christ the Gentiles had also received this inheritance - Eph. 1:10-12

We have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ - Rom. 5:1

This mystery had now been revealed to the saints - Col. 1:24-26

That mystery is Christ in you, the hope of glory - Col. 1:27

Paul asked for prayer for an open door to speak the mystery of Christ - Col. 4:3

d. Paul said this mystery had not been revealed in the past - 3:5

This mystery was not known in other ages

This mystery was known to God from eternity - Acts 15:18

To you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom of God - Luke 8:10

This mystery was revealed to us at the time that God chose - 1 Cor. 4:1

In time past the Gentiles were without Christ - Eph. 2:12

This mystery was now being revealed to the sons of men

Abraham was to be a blessing to all families (but not explained) - Gen. 12:3

Paul explained this meant we would be one in Christ - Gal. 3:28-29

This mystery had been revealed by the Holy Spirit

We received the Spirit of adoption - Rom. 8:14-17

This mystery was revealed to us by the Holy Spirit - 1 Cor. 2:13

This mystery had been revealed to His holy apostles

The apostles were chosen to know the mysteries of the kingdom - Matt. 13:11

The apostles spoke about this mystery - Eph. 3:8-9

This mystery had been revealed to His prophets

Job knew that His Redeemer lives and would stand on the earth - Job 19:25

The Redeemer of the fatherless is mighty - Prov. 23:10-11

Isaiah said My Servant (Christ) was given as a light to the Gentiles - Is. 49:6

Paul and the prophets wrote about this mystery - Eph. 3:3

2. The church is where Jews and Gentiles become one - 3:6-7

a. This mystery was that Jews and Gentiles would be one in the church - 3:6

God planned that the Gentiles would be fellow heirs

Christ broke down the wall of separation between Jew and Gentile - Eph. 3:13-22

We become heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ - Rom. 8:17

Christians become spiritual heirs of the promise given to Abraham - Gal. 3:29

God planned that Jews and Gentiles would be the same body

By one Spirit we were all baptized into one body - 1 Cor. 12:13

We become fellow members of one body - Eph. 2:16

There is one body and one Spirit - Eph. 4:4

We are called into one body - Col. 3:8-15

God planned the Gentiles would be partakers of His promise

Christ made us all a part of the family of God - Gal. 3:26-28

Christ made us heirs of His promise - Gal. 3:29

God planned this would be made possible in Christ

We are one body in Christ and members one of another - Rom. 12:4-5

Christ is the One who made us His body - 1 Cor. 12:27

God planned that this would be shared through the Gospel

The Gospel is the power of God for both Jews and Gentiles - Rom. 1:16

Paul said that he became a minister of this plan of God

Paul was called to take the faith to all nations - Rom. 1:5

Christ is the One who made Paul a minister - 1 Tim. 1:12-17

Paul said this was according to the gift of grace given to him

Paul served the Lord through the grace given to him - Rom. 12:3

Paul was made a minister of Jesus Christ to the Gentiles - Rom. 15:15-16

Christ showed mercy to Paul - 1 Tim. 1:13

It is in the true grace of God that we stand - 1 Pet. 5:12

Paul said this happened through the effective working of God's power

We see the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe - Eph. 1:19

Paul said His working works in us mightily - Col. 1:29

It is this same power which raised Christ from the dead - Col. 2:12

Christ chose to show His power in Paul - 1 Tim. 1:16

a. Paul was called to declare this purpose - 3:8

He said he was the least of all the saints

Paul was the last of all those who saw Christ - 1 Cor. 5:8

Paul was the least of the apostles - 1 Cor. 15:9

He was given grace to preach

Paul had been given grace by God to minister - Rom. 15:15-17

The message Paul preached was not according to man - Gal. 1:10-11

Paul received this message so he could preach among the Gentiles - Gal. 1:16

He was called to declare the unsearchable riches of Christ

The wisdom of God is so great His ways are unsearchable - Rom. 11:33

Paul had been called by God to share the message - 1 Tim. 2:7

b. Paul was called to reveal this mystery

This mystery is the basis of fellowship for all people - 3:9

The bread...is it not the communion of the body of Christ? - 1 Cor. 10:16-17

This fellowship of Jews and Gentiles was shown by the church - Gal. 2:9

Paul had been given a commission to all the Gentiles - 2 Tim. 4:17

As we walk in the light we have fellowship with one another - 1 John 1:7

This mystery was hidden by God

God made known to us the mystery of His will - Eph. 1:9

Paul said this mystery was not known in other ages - Eph. 3:5

This mystery included the fact that the church is the body of Christ - Col. 1:24-28

As Paul spoke the mystery of Christ this included His body - Col. 4:3

c. Paul was revealing the greatness of the wisdom of God - 3:10

This wisdom was being revealed through Paul

Paul had been chosen to reveal the hidden wisdom of God - 1 Cor. 2:7

Paul prayed that all Christians would understand the wisdom of God - Eph. 1:17

Paul prayed the Colossians would be filled with all wisdom - Col. 1:9

In God are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge - Col. 2:3

This wisdom had not been revealed to the angels

The powers in heaven saw this mystery revealed in the church - Eph. 3:11

The church was the mystery of godliness seen by angels - Eph. 3:15-16

Peter says that there are many things the angels desire to know - 1 Pet. 1:12

d. Paul was revealing the eternal purpose of God - 3:11

This purpose was the eternal purpose of God

God works all things for good for those who love God - Rom. 8:28-29

God had this purpose from eternity past - Eph. 1:9

God's purpose is according to His will - Eph. 1:11

God revealed this purpose at the time that He chose - Eph. 3:5

This purpose was carried out in Christ Jesus

God called us through Christ according to His purpose - 2 Tim. 1:9

Timothy had seen Paul carefully follow this purpose - 2 Tim. 3:10

e. Paul was revealing the access that we have through Christ - 3:12

We have boldness because of Christ

We can come through Christ with boldness - Heb. 4:14-16

We have boldness to enter into the presence of God through Christ - 10:19-22

We have confident access through faith in Christ

We have access to the Father into this grace through Christ - Rom. 5:1-2

We have access by one Spirit to the Father - Eph. 2:18

The Spirit makes intercession according to the will of God - Rom. 8:26-27

H. God is the One is able to do more than we could ever imagine - 3:13-21

1. Paul gives us a model for prayer - 3:13-15

a. This prayer did not focus on Paul - 3:13

Paul did not want the Christians to get discouraged

Since God has given us this ministry we are not to lose heart - 2 Cor. 4:1

We are not to lose heart even though our outward man is perishing - 2 Cor. 4:16

Paul said he experienced "light affliction" which was for a moment - 2 Cor. 4:17

We will be rewarded if we do not faint - Gal. 3:8-10

We are not to grow weary while doing good - Gal. 6:9

We are not to get tired of doing good - 2 Thess. 3:13

Paul was willing to suffer for the sake of other Christians

Paul said his suffering was nothing compared to future glory - Rom. 8:18

Paul was willing to be afflicted for other Christians - 2 Cor. 1:6

Paul was a prisoner of Christ for the sake of the Gentiles - Eph. 3:1

He was glad his suffering led to boldness in others - Phil. 1:12-14

Paul was willing to let others misuse his name for the Gospel - Phil. 1:15-18

b. This prayer was to the Father - 3:14

Paul bowed his knees to the Father

Paul continually bowed his knees for the Ephesians - Eph. 1:16-19
Daniel and many others showed humbleness before God in prayer - Dan. 6:10

Paul recognized the relationship between the Father and Christ

This relationship brings glory to both - John 17:4-5
Christ also gives this glory to those who follow Him - John 17:24
Christ came according to the power of an endless life - Heb. 7:16-17

c. This prayer was to the Father of all saints - 3:15

God is the Father of all saints now in heaven

This includes all Old Testament saints - Eph. 4:8-10
This includes all New Testament saints who have died - 1 Thess. 4:13-18

God is the Father of all saints still on the earth

God sees us as already seated in heavenly places - Eph. 2:6
We are all the children of God and will be like Him - 1 John 3:1-3

2. Paul prayed that they would be strengthened with might - 3:16

This strength comes from the Father

This growth in strength was modeled by Christ - Luke 2:40
This strength comes as we humble ourselves before God - 1 Pet. 5:6
God gives us His strength as we are humble before Him - James 4:6-10

This strength is according to the riches of His glory

The riches include His goodness, forbearance and longsuffering - Rom. 2:4
Our forgiveness is based on His riches - Eph. 1:7
Our inheritance is based on His riches - Eph. 1:18

Our kindness that we will receive is based on His riches - Eph. 2:7
This strength is given to the least as a result of His grace - Eph. 3:8

This strength comes through the power of the Spirit

The disciples were to wait until they received the Holy Spirit - Acts 24:49
The Spirit is our only source of power - Acts 1:8
Our Gospel came in power and in the Holy Spirit - 1 Thess. 1:5

This strength becomes present in our inner man

The inner man of Christians delights in the law of God - Rom. 7:22
This strength is quenched when we depend on our own strength - 1 Thess. 5:19
This strength gives us His power - Col. 1:11
This strength renews our inner man day by day - 2 Cor. 4:16

3. Pray prayed that they would become rooted in the love of Christ -3:17-19a

a. We are to be rooted and grounded in the love of Christ - 3:17

Christ dwells in our hearts by faith

Christ lives in us so we can walk by faith - 2 Cor. 5:7

Christ lives in us so we can live by faith - Gal. 2:20

Christ will ground us in the faith as we are grounded and steadfast - Col. 1:23

Christ wants us to let the peace of God rule in our hearts - Col. 3:15

Christ comforts our hearts and establishes us - 2 Thess. 2:17

Christ is greater than he that is in the world - I John 4:4

Christ roots us and grounds us in His love

Christ roots us in Himself and in His love - Col. 2:6-7

Christ also establishes and builds us up in the faith - Col. 2:7

Christ grounds us and makes us steadfast as we abide in Him - Col. 1:23

b. We are to comprehend the greatness of the love of Christ - 3:18

We can comprehend this love only as we are rooted in it

We become rooted by spending time with Christ - John 13:34-35

This happens as we abide in Christ and His Word abides in us - John 15:7-8

We are to understand the four dimensions of Christ's love

Oh, the depth of the riches both of wisdom and knowledge of God - Rom. 11:33

(those riches are past finding out without God in control)

The Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God - 1 Cor. 2:10

His love fills both space and time - Eph. 1:4

c. We are to know the love of Christ which surpasses human knowledge-3:19a

We are to know the love of Christ

Nothing can separate us from the love of Christ - Rom. 8:35-39

Christ loved me and gave Himself for me - Gal. 2:20

The love of Christ becomes what motivates us - 2 Cor. 5:14-15

We are to walk in love as Christ also loved us and gave Himself for us - Eph. 5:2

Our love is to abound still more and more - Phil. 1:9

The Lord make you to increase and abound in love to one another - 1 Thess. 3:6

This love comes from Christ and is to flow through us to others - 1 John 1:5

This love surpasses human knowledge

The thoughts and ways of God are beyond human understanding - Is. 55:8-9

This love surpasses all understanding and guards our hearts - Phil. 4:7

4. Paul prayed that they would be filled with the fullness of God - 3:19b

We are to be filled with all the fullness of God

Christ is the head of the church - Eph. 1:22-23

Understanding the fullness of God

To be filled with God is to humble self - Phil. 2:8

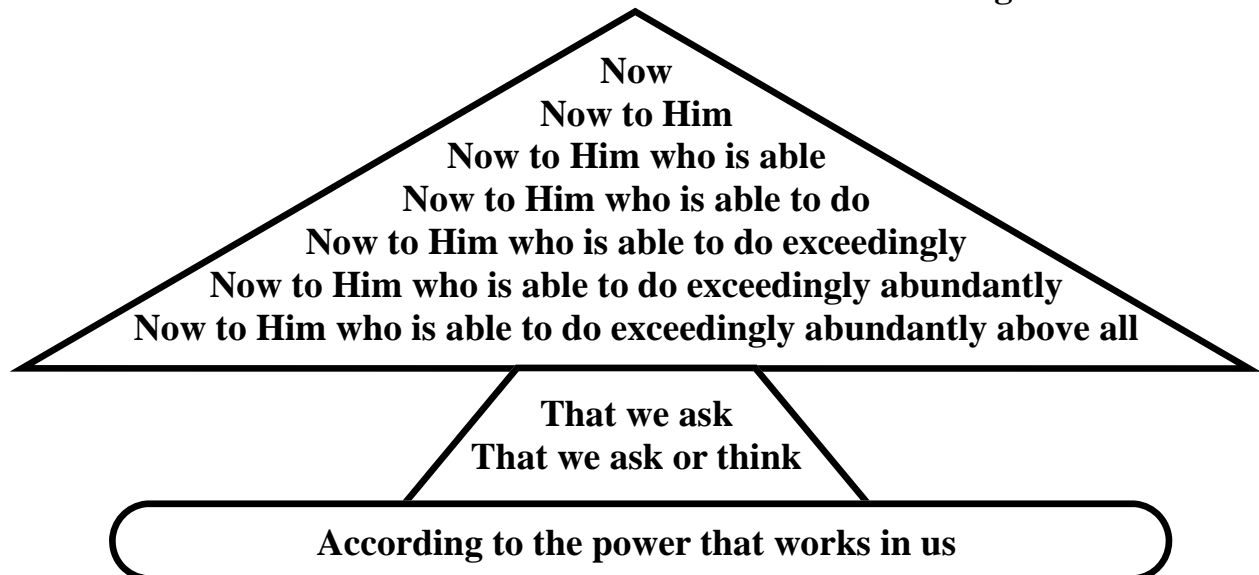

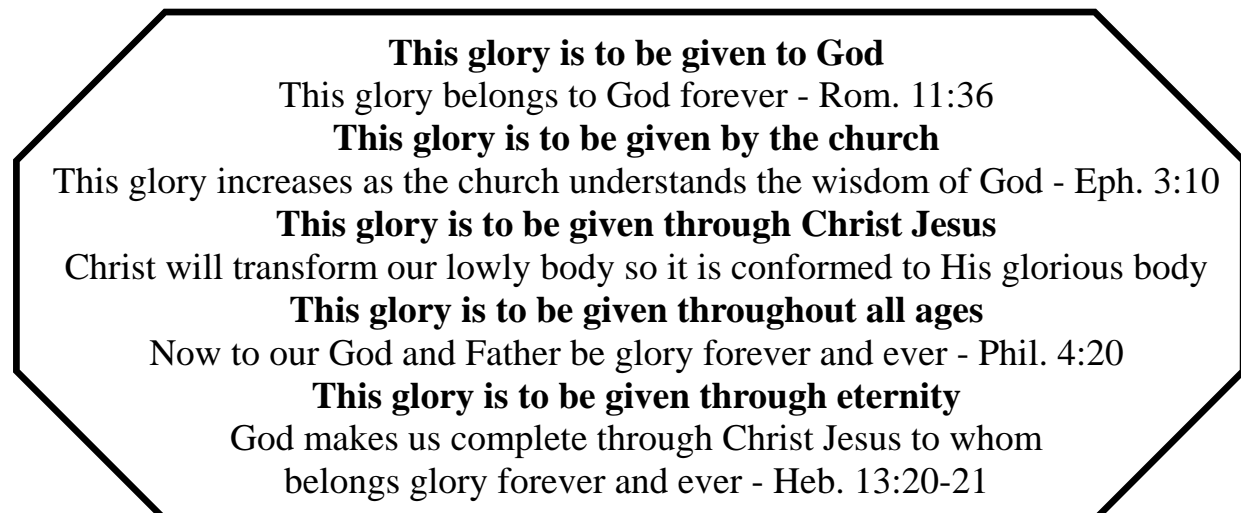

A. God wants us to be one with other Christians - 4:1-6

1. Our desire should be a worthy walk - 4:1-2

a. We are to walk worthy of our calling - 4:1

Paul was a prisoner of the Lord

Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles - Eph. 3:1

Paul did not view himself as a prisoner of men - Philem. 9

Paul was making a request in humbleness

I, Paul am pleading with...and gentleness of Christ - 2 Cor. 10:1

Paul did not demand but rather requested - Philem. 1:8-11

Paul wanted all Christians to walk worthy of our calling

A worthy walk is a walk in love - Eph. 5:2

Walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him - Col. 1:10

Walk worthy of God who calls you into His own kingdom - 1 Thess. 2:12

b. We are to walk with a humble attitude - 4:2

This attitude includes a humble opinion of self

We are to give preference to one another - Rom. 12:10

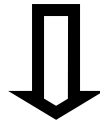

Fathers are to teach the next generation - Ps. 78:4-7
Godly fathers urge their children to imitate them - 1 Cor. 4:14-16
Godly fathers teach their children how to walk worthy of God - 1 Thess. 2:10-12

Fathers are not to provoke their children to wrath

Fathers are not to provoke or discourage their children - Col. 3:21
Fathers are to discipline and correct their children - Heb. 12:9-11
Fathers are to discipline but not destroy - Prov. 19:18
Fathers are to correct through loving discipline - Prov. 22:15

Fathers are to bring their children up in the training of the Lord

Godly training must begin with a godly example - 1 Cor. 11:1
Training is best done by using the Word of God - 2 Tim. 3:16-17
Training is to be done with gentleness - 2 Tim. 2:25
Training has as its focus growth in godly living - Titus 2:12
Training includes chastening and discipline - Heb. 12:5-11

Fathers are to bring their children up in the admonition of the Lord

Fathers are to give wisdom by discipline and rebuke - Pro. 29:15
Fathers are to admonish and warn in love - 1 Cor. 4:14
Fathers warn children to bring them to maturity - Col. 1:28
Fathers can admonish children through music - Col. 3:16
Spiritual fathers are to admonish spiritual children - 1 Thess. 5:12
Fathers are to warn the unruly - 1 Thess. 5:14

I. God describes the Spirit filled life for employees and employers - 6:5-9

1. Spirit led employees will work to please the Lord - 6:5-8

a. Employees will obey their masters as if they were obeying the Lord - 6:5

Employees (bondservants) are to be obedient to their masters

Bondservants are to obey their masters in all things - Col. 3:22

Bondservants are to be well pleasing in all things - Titus 2:9-10

The only exception to obedience is when it would disobey God - Acts 5:29

Employees talk about all who have employers or masters here on earth

Christians are to realize we are bondservants of God - 1 Pet. 2:15-16

Employers are to obey with fear (respect) and trembling

Servants are to be submissive to their masters with all fear - 1 Pet. 2:18

Employees are to do this in sincerity of heart

We want to do all that we do with a pure heart - 1 Tim. 1:5

We are to have a clear conscience before God for the way we work - 1 Pet. 2:19

Employees are to respect their employers as they respect Christ

Employees are to obey their employers from the heart - Col. 3:22-24

Employees are to realize Christian employers are brethren beloved - 1 Tim. 6:2

Employees are to please their masters in all things - Titus 2:9-10

b. Employees (slaves) will seek to do the will of God - 6:6

This is not just when the employer is watching

We are to do all to the glory of God - 1 Cor. 10:31

We are to work with reverence toward God - Col. 3:22

We are to live our lives to carry out the will of God - 1 Pet. 4:2

This is what many do to please their employers

We are to avoid causing God and His doctrine to be blasphemed - 1 Tim. 6:1

We are to adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things - Titus 2:10

This is to be done as bondservants of Christ

We are to work to please the Lord and He will reward us - Col. 3:23-24

As a servant of the Lord we are not to quarrel but be gentle - 2 Tim. 2:24

This means doing the will of God from the heart

Those who do the will of God are part of the family of Christ - Mark 3:35

Employees are to seek to understand the will of God - Eph. 5:17

Employees are to honor those in authority - 1 Pet. 2:13-16

Those who do the will of God will abide forever - 1 John 2:17

c. Employees will seek to serve the Lord - 6:7

Employees will do this with goodwill

Employees are to do all to the glory of God - 1 Cor. 10:31-33

Godly employees will do this with an attitude of service

We are to serve in the newness of the Spirit - Rom. 7:6

This includes serving both non-Christians and Christians - 1 Tim. 6:2

Employees will do this to please the Lord and not just men

Employees are to do all they do to the Lord - Col. 3:23

d. Employees will look to the Lord for provision - 6:8

Employees know that the Lord is observing all that they do

We are to do whatever we do to the glory of God - 1 Cor. 10:31

The Lord observes when we do good and suffer - 1 Pet. 2:20

The Lord will commend us before the Father - 1 Pet. 2:20

Employees are to look to the Lord to reward us

Employees are to look to the Lord for reward - Col. 3:24

Employees will see Christ provide needs as they honor Him - Phil. 4:19

We are to do this whether we are bondslaves or free

This will change our attitudes as we work - Eph. 6:6

2. Spirit led employers will show respect to employees - 6:9

Godly employers will also seek to serve our Master (the Lord)

At salvation our sins are blotted out - Acts 3:19

Our Master is in heaven (He is interceding for us) - Col. 4:1

Employers are to treat their employees fairly - Rom. 4:8

Employers who are not fair will be judged - James 5:4

The half-brothers of Christ recognized Him as Lord - James 1:1; Jude 4

Godly employers will not threaten

Employers are to treat others the way they want to be treated - Matt. 7:12

Christ the Lord washed the feet of the disciples - John 13:13-14

Christ gave us the real example by not threatening - 1 Pet. 2:23

Godly employers will seek to please the Lord, their Master

Christ gave His disciples a great ministry - John 21:15-17

God does not show partiality in salvation - Acts 10:34-35

Christ does not show partiality when He rewards - Col. 3:24-25

Godly masters will give what is just and fair - Col. 4:1

Christ calls us to avoid all partiality - James 2:1-10

III. The protection that we have in Christ as Christians - 6:10-24

A. God describes our enemy as Christians - 6:10-12

1. We are to depend on the strength of the Lord - 6:10

We are to be strong in the Lord

Christ is the source of our strength - Phil. 4:13

We can have strength because of the grace Christ provides - 2 Tim. 2:1

We are to be strong in the power of His might

Christ causes His mighty power to work through us - Eph. 1:19

Paul prayed for Christians to be strengthened with all might - Col. 1:11

The power of Satan was defeated at the cross - Heb. 2:14

Christ gives us this strength to minister effectively - 1 Pet. 4:11

2. We are to put on the whole armor of God - 6:11

We are to put on the whole armor of God

Satan experiences defeat as we depend on the power of God - 2 Cor. 10:3-5

God calls us to put on the entire armor not just some parts - Eph. 6:13

We will then be able to stand against the wiles of the devil

God tells us that the devil is very deceptive - 2 Cor. 11:3, 13-15

3. We are to understand our enemy - 6:12

Our fight is not against human enemies

God says our fight is not a physical fight - 1 Cor. 9:25-27

God says that our fight is a spiritual fight - 2 Cor. 10:3-5

Our fight is against principalities

Principalities are the first created angels who became demons - Col. 1:16

Christ disarmed the principalities and powers - Col. 2:15

Our fight is against powers

Satan is the prince of the power of the air - Eph. 2:2

All authorities and power have been made subject to Christ - 1 Pet. 3:22

Our fight is against the rulers of the darkness of this world

Christ has turned us from darkness to light - Acts 26:18

God delivered us from the power of darkness - Col. 1:13

Our fight is against spiritual wickedness in high places

Satan is the wicked one - 1 John 2:13-14

B. God describes our armor as Christians - 6:13-20

1. Spiritual armor is for defense - 6:13-17a

a. We are to take the full armor of God - 6:13

We are to take (put on) the full armor of God

Wiles speak of the fact that the devil lies in wait to deceive - Eph. 4:14

The full armor will help us stand against the wiles of the devil - Eph. 6:11

The full armor will give us strength to withstand in the evil day

We are to redeem the time because the days are evil - Eph. 5:16

The Lord warned that the days will become more evil - 2 Tim. 3:1-7

Resisting in the Lord's strength requires a humble attitude - James 4:7

We withstand the devil by being steadfast in the faith - 1 Pet. 5:8-9

We will have full joy as we fellowship with the Lord - 1 John 1:3-4

We are to make every preparation to stand

The Lord is able to make us stand complete in all the will of God - Col. 4:12

We are able to stand in the true grace of God - 1 Pet. 5:14

We have access by faith into this grace in which we stand - Rom. 5:2

This is why we must walk by faith and not by sight - 2 Cor. 5:7

b. We are to stand strong in Christ - 6:14

We do not stand in our own strength

We can do nothing in our own strength - John 15:5

Christ's strength is made perfect in our weakness - 2 Cor. 12:9

Christ told the apostles He would give them a mouth and wisdom - Luke 21:15

The synagogue of the Freedmen was not able to resist Stephen - Acts 6:9-10

We can do all things as we depend on the strength of Christ - Phil. 4:13

God gives more grace by resisting the proud - James 4:6-7

We resist the devil in the strength that Christ provides - 1 Pet. 5:8-9

We have had our loins girded with truth

We are to be committed to knowing the truth - John 8:31-32

We are to be committed to obeying the truth - James 1:22

We purify ourselves in obeying the truth through the Spirit - 1 Pet. 1:22

We have been given the breastplate of righteousness

We have been given the righteousness of Christ - Phil. 3:9

We are to grow in our obedience to that righteousness - Phil. 3:10-14

This is also the breastplate of faith and love - 1 Thess. 5:8

c. We are to have our message ready - 6:15

We have had our feet shod with the gospel of peace

Christ said we are to preach the gospel to every creature - Mark 16:15
Paul's ministry was to testify to the gospel of the grace of God - Acts 20:24
Paul said he was not ashamed of the gospel of Christ - Rom. 1:16
Paul endured all things to minister the Gospel of Christ - 1 Cor. 9:12
Some turned from the grace of Christ to another gospel - Gal. 1:6
These false teachers wanted to pervert the gospel of Christ - Gal. 1:7
The message of the cross of Christ is the message of peace - Gal. 6:16
We have the peace of God controlling our hearts and minds - Phil. 4:4-7
We have the God of peace with us in spiritual battle - Phil. 4:8-9

d. We are to have Biblical protection - 6:16

Christ tells us to take certain things in order to stand

We will fail to stand in our own strength - John 15:5; Rom. 7:19
We are to present ourselves as slaves to obey - Rom. 6:16
This is necessary because of our human weakness - Rom. 6:19
The Lord even uses our failures to conform us to His image - Rom. 8:28-29
No created thing can separate us from the love of Christ - Rom. 8:35-39
That is why we are to take the whole armor of God - Rom. 6:11

We are to take the shield of faith

The shield of faith provides protection from temptation - 1 Cor. 10:12-13
This faith gives us an eternal viewpoint - 2 Cor. 4:16-18
This faith quenches all the fiery darts of Satan - 1 Pet. 5:8-9
This faith causes us to know the wicked one cannot touch us - 1 John 5:18-19

This protection will quench all the fiery darts of the wicked

This is how to have victory over evil from within us - Mark 7:21-23
As evil heart will cause us to depart from the living God - Heb. 3:12
This is why we are not to quench the Spirit - 1 Thess. 5:19

e. We are to take the helmet of salvation - 6:17a

The helmet of salvation is the hope of salvation - 1 Thess. 5:8
That hope is based on the resurrection of Christ - 1 Cor. 15:12-21
That hope is based on the return of Christ - 1 Thess. 4:13-18
That hope we have as an anchor of the soul - Heb. 6:17-19

2. Spiritual armor is for offense - 6:17b-18

a. The sword of the Spirit is one of our weapons - 6:17b

We are to take the sword of the Spirit

The sword of the Spirit is greater than a human sword - Heb. 4:12

The sword of the Spirit defeats Satan - Matthew 4:4, 7, 10-11

The Word of God is sharper than a two-edged sword - Heb. 4:12

We are to realize that the sword of the Spirit is the Word of God

The Word of God is living and powerful - Heb. 4:12

The Word of God is greater than our words - Is. 55:8-9

The Word of God will take away our fear of man - Heb. 13:5-6

b. Prayer is our other weapon - 6:18

We are to pray always

We are to pray at all times - 1 Thess. 5:17

We are to pray for all people - 1 Tim. 2:1

We are to pray in all places - 1 Tim. 2:8

We are to pray with prayer and supplication

Prayer speaks of general prayer addressed to God - Col. 4:2, 12

Supplication (petition) refers to specific requests to God - Phil. 4:6

We are to pray in the Spirit

We pray to the Father through the Spirit - Rom. 8:15

We pray in the Spirit for the will of God - Rom. 8:26-27

We are to pray with all perseverance

We are to continue in prayer to avoid temptation - Matt. 26:41

We are to continue in prayer until Christ comes - Mark 13:33-37

We are to continue in prayer and watch - Col. 4:2

We are to pray with all supplication (petition)

We are to pray for forgiveness - Matt. 6:12; 1 John 1:9

We are to pray for victory over temptation - Matt. 6:13

We are to pray for the salvation of others - Rom. 10:1

We are to pray for the ministry of one another - 2 Cor. 1:11

We are to pray for Christians in other areas - 2 Cor. 9:14

We are to pray for victory for one another - James 5:16

We are to pray for all saints

We are to pray for the spiritual growth of all Christians - Eph. 3:14-21

We are to pray for fruitfulness for all Christians - Col. 1:9-13

3. Spiritual armor caused Paul to speak boldly for Christ - 6:19-20

a. Paul asked the Ephesians to pray for him - 6:19

He asked them to pray for utterance

Paul realized that we lack personal strength - 2 Cor. 1:8-11

Paul realized that God is the One who opens the door - Col. 4:3

Paul wanted people to pray that the Word would spread quickly - 2 Thess. 3:1

He asked them to pray he would open his mouth boldly

When we spend time with Christ we can speak boldly - Acts 4:13

When we are filled with the Spirit we can speak boldly - Acts 4:31

Paul had come to Corinth in fear, and in much trembling - 1 Cor. 2:3

The Lord spoke to Paul in a vision to encourage him - Acts 18:9

When we are filled with hope we can speak boldly - 2 Cor. 3:4-12

He asked them to pray that he would be able to share the Gospel

Paul was chosen to reveal the mystery of the gospel - Eph. 3:3-7

Paul's goal to share the Gospel where it had not been heard - Rom. 15:20-21

Paul also had a goal to bring people to spiritual maturity - Col. 1:26-29

We are to equip faithful men to teach others also - 2 Tim. 2:2

b. Paul had a desire to speak to please God - 6:20

This is because Christians are ambassadors for God

Paul was an ambassador for Christ in chains - Acts 28:16; 30-31

An ambassador for Christ calls people to be reconciled to God - 2 Cor. 5:20

Paul was the prisoner of Christ when he wrote Ephesians - Eph. 3:1

The chains of Paul encouraged others to speak boldly also - Phil. 1:14

Paul had begotten Onesimus while in chains - Phile. 1:10-11

This is because we are to speak boldly

We are to speak boldly and without fear - Phil. 1:12-14

We are to speak with the love that casts out fear - 1 John 4:18

This is because speaking boldly is the way we ought to speak

We are to obey God rather than men - Acts 5:29

We are to speak the Word with confidence - Acts 28:31

We are to speak the Word of God without shame - Phil. 1:20

We are to make the Gospel clear to others - Col. 4:3-4

We are to speak the Word even when facing opposition - 1 Thess. 2:2

We are to be willing to lay down our lives as we speak - 1 John 3:16

We are to be bold as we contend for the faith - Jude 3

C. God wants us to be concerned for one another - 6:21-24

1. Paul sent Tychicus to tell what was happening to him - 6:21-22

a. Tychicus was a faithful servant of God - 6:21

He would tell how Paul was doing

Paul realized how God was working - Phil. 1:12

He was a beloved brother

Paul had a real love for Tychicus - Col. 4:7

Paul later sent Tychicus to Ephesus - 2 Tim. 4:12

He was a faithful servant of God

Paul had added Tychicus to his ministry team - Acts 20:4

b. Tychicus was sent to encourage the Ephesians - 6:22

He was sent with a purpose

Paul sent Tychicus to encourage the brethren - Col. 4:7-8

People are encouraged when their hearts are knit together in love - Col. 2:1-2

He would tell what was happening to Paul

Paul wanted to keep the Christians informed - Col. 4:9

He would encourage the Ephesians

Paul knew that Tychicus had a ministry of encouragement - 2 Tim. 4:12

Paul wanted the brethren to experience peace and love - 6:23-24

Peace is something God wants us all to experience - 6:23

Peace can be our experience

Peace has its source in the Father and Christ - Rom. 1:7

Peace is our experience as we are obedient to God - Phil. 4:9

Love with faith comes from the Father and Christ

Love has its source in the Father and Christ - John 17:23

Grace is present with all who love Christ - 6:24

Timothy was to be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus - 2 Tim. 2:1

We are to let our speech always be seasoned with grace - Col. 4:6

We are to be good stewards of the manifold grace of God - 1 Pet. 4:10
